Brian Raum serves as senior counsel with the Alliance Defense Fund at its Team Resource Center in Scottsdale, Arizona, where he heads a team of attorneys defending marriage and the family for the ADF Marriage Litigation Center.

Since joining ADF in 2006, Raum has defended marriage as the union of one man and one woman in numerous lawsuits across the nation, including New York, California, Rhode Island, Oklahoma, Massachusetts, and New Jersey.

Raum earned his J.D. in 1994 from the Regent University School of Law, where he was a member of the dean's list with honors. He served seven years with the American Center for Law and Justice, first as a law clerk and eventually as the attorney in charge of its New York office. Following ACLJ, Raum maintained a private practice in New York City, engaging in constitutional and civil litigation until accepting a full-time position with ADF. He received a B.S. in Business Administration from Lee University 1991.

Practicing law since 1995, Raum is admitted to the bar in the states of Virginia and New York, along with the federal bars in all the districts of New York, as well as the Central District of Illinois and the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second, Third, Seventh, Ninth, and Federal Circuits. He currently resides in Phoenix, Arizona.
